

LAGREIN ROSÉ

2010

Grape variety: Lagrein.

Description: pink colour with ruby hints. Quite pronounced, fruity aroma (red berries) with floral impressions (violets). Medium-bodied smooth fruit on the palate, fresh. Long lasting aftertaste with an elegant bitter twist. This wine should be drunk within 2 years from production.

Suggested food: flavourful appetizers and starters, smoked fish, pâtés and terrines, pasta dishes, white meat and poultry.

Origin: vineyards in the Bolzano area along the Talvera river and in the area of Ora at an altitude of 230 to 300 metres (750 - 980 feet); deep and rich alluvial soils. Very warm eme-soclimate.

Age of the vines: 10 – 45 years.

Harvested: mid - end september 2010.

Yield: 65 hl / ha.

Vinification: immediate pressing of the grapes; thereafter fermentation in stainless steel tanks. Sur-lie aging for 4 months in stainless steel.

Alcohol: 13 % by vol.

Acidity: 5.3 g / litre.

Bottled: January 2011.

Release: January 2011.
